### 2017-18 Rep Tryouts begin on April 17th

All players trying out for 2017-2018 Rep Teams will be required to register and pay the necessary fees prior to participating. **Players may be required to provide proof of residency at the tryout.** 

It is strongly recommended that players <u>register online</u> at least one week prior to—and no less than 48 hours before—their first tryout session. The tryout fee with advance online registration is \$65 (payment can be made online by credit/PayPal or in cash at the door). **Players who do not register in advance must complete the form and pay \$80 in cash at the door upon arrival at the first tryout session.** Note : there is NO FEE for attending Novice tryouts.
