

CODE OF CONDUCT PLEDGE FOR TEAM OFFICIALS (MANAGERS, TRAINERS, STAFF)

It is the intention of this pledge to promote proper behaviour and respect for all participants within the GGHA. All team officials/staff must sign this pledge before being allowed to participate in hockey and must continue to observe the principles of Fair Play. Failure to observe the Code of Conduct may result in GGHA disciplinary action.

- Winning is a consideration, but not the only one, nor the most important one. Care more about the child than winning the game.
- Be a positive role model to your players, display emotional maturity and be alert to the physical safety of players.
- Show respect for on-ice and off-ice officials at all times.
- · I will treat opposing teams with respect. Without them, there would be no game.
- Be generous with your praise when it is deserved; be consistent, honest; fair and just; do not criticize players publicly; be an effective communicator and coach.
- Adjust to personal needs and problems of players, be a good listener, never verbally or physically abuse a player or
 official; give all players the opportunity to improve their skills, gain confidence and develop self-esteem.
