We're writing you about a few more changes at our recreation facilities due to COVID-19. On Friday, November 13th the Provincial Government moved Wellington-Dufferin-Guelph Public Health areas to Level ORANGE-RESTRICT. These changes are designed to further protect you, your families, our employees and our community.

For recreation services, including your sport, the move to Level ORANGE has the following impact:

- We are enhancing our visitor/documentation practices and each rental will be required to provide a **hard copy** list prior to using the facility and must include the following:
 1. Name and phone number for each participant
 2. Name and phone number for parents/guardians attending
 3. Confirmation that everyone attending has completed a self-assessment
- If you don't already have a COVID-19 documentation form, you can use the sample form provided with this message.
- No spectators are permitted (exemption for parent/guardian supervision of children)
- You're already doing your part, and we thank you, for screening your participants for COVID-19 symptoms before they participate in classes, programs, practices, games or events at City facilities.
- To ensure your event starts and ends on time, please prepare this documentation on the day of your scheduled event before you arrive at a City of Guelph recreation facility.

Please arrive on time so your group can enter the facility

Please ensure participants arrive on time to avoid any confusion when you arrive. The number/names of people on your document **MUST** match the number/names of people entering the facility for your event.

Any personal information we collect will only be used for the purposes of tracing contact with cases of COVID-19. We will protect, and then destroy any personal information collected.

Your cooperation can prevent further restrictions and closures

Again, we thank you for taking the extra time to prepare the documentation in advance, so we can further protect you, your families, our employees and our community. Please continue following all public health guidelines so we can continue offering fun, safe sports and recreation programs in Guelph. Like you, we want to return to play.
