#### **Tournament Rink Locations and Parking**

We will be using 4 rinks across Guelph for the tournament.

#### West End Community Centre - 21 Imperial Road, S.

• The Tournament headquarters is in the Lion's Lair, just inside the doors to Arena 1. The room will also contain a small concession stand and PWHL merchandise. *Remember to park in the far lot, past the arena doors on the west side of the Centre.* 

#### **Exhibition Arena - 70 Division Street**

• The tournament office is in the West lobby (closest to the baseball diamond).

#### Centennial Arena - 376 College Ave West

• The tournament desk is in the lobby.

#### Victoria Rd Arena – 151 Victoria Road, N.

• The arena is accessed via the Centre doors farthest from the parking lot. The Tournament desk is just as you go into the arena.
